All patients must be sure to contact their insurance company prior to procedures in order to confirm the coverage.

- Call the Member Service phone number on the back of your insurance card
- Check which facility is In-Network for your insurance (i.e., lab, hospital, etc.)
- Provide Member Services with ICD-10 diagnosis codes and CPT codes of each lab or diagnostic test associated with the orders
  - ICD-10 codes can be found on your lab slip or test order
  - Lab testing: The most common CPT codes for lab tests are noted below.
  - Diagnostic testing: If the CPT code is not listed on your order, please call the office and ask to speak to Referrals.
